Architectural Control Committee Procedures for Establishing a Little Lending Library

- 1. Steward must contact CCHOA and obtain Stewardship Agreement, sign and return.
- 2. Plans shall be submitted to the CCHOA and referred to the Architectural Control Committee.
- 3. Deposit for stand and installation shall be made to the CCHOA.
- 4. ACC will review plans and send approval back to the CCHOA.
- 5. Little Lending Library will be built and dropped off at the CCHOA.
- 6. CCHOA will designate location, complete installation, and notify the steward when the Little Lending Library is ready for use.
- 7. CCHOA will publicize location and steward (if they want) for each lending library.

Architectural Control Committee, Design Guidelines for Little Lending Libraries

Plan submission:

- 1. Builder/Steward must submit picture or sketch of overall structure including dimensions.
- 2. All materials must be called out and include specifications for hardware, siding, roofing, doors and windows.
- 3. Stain colors, paint colors, roof colors must be specified.
- 4. Waterproofing must be noted.
- 5. Each structure will be evaluated individually for construction and suitability for proposed location.

Guidelines:

- 1. Structure must be made of sustainable materials suitable for outdoor use.
- 2. Structure must be no bigger than 48" wide and 30" tall.
- 3. Base of structure must be flat and suitable for attachment to metal plate/pole.
- 4. Structure must have waterproof coating, hinges and parts that are weather sustainable, and a way to protect the books.
- 5. Structure must provide a way for easy use by children.
- 6. Paint colors and stains must be approved by the committee.
